Samantha: I remember me and my mom like, sat down for hours one night and just like, printed out all my transcripts and like, entered everything both, for the CSU, and the UC applications.

Darnell: Entering the transcript information is really taxing and takes a lot of time when you don't have that CCGI component.

Samantha: Doing Cal State applications were the best because CCGI just made it so easy to enter their courses and their grades. There was no work to do. They just pressed the little button and everything just transferred over.

Crystal: To transport their grades and all of their information from CCGI to the CSU applications, it's just basically two buttons, and you're good to go.

Darnell: I can't think of a single student that wanted to quit and give up, and then when they get to the end, as soon as they're like, "I did it?", and then "Oh, thank you so much!".

Darnell: And then, you know, just getting them to the door in the sense of actually filling out the application like, getting to see what that process is like, and kind of making it easy for them really helps. If a student knows that there's gold on the other side of a door, and it says you have to solve a Rubik's Cube to get through the door there's going to be more students that get through the door if it's a simple twist of a knob versus the Rubik's Cube.
